Join us **Friday, July 16, 2010** in the conference room of the Eastern Contractor's Association building in Albany for the third installment in the 2010 series of Block Producer Safety Workshops. The workshop begins at **8:00 AM** and will conclude at **1:30 PM**.

Safety Workshop Topics:

- **Code Rule 60**, which established the Workplace Safety and Loss Prevention Incentive Program. This program offers a credit to: self-insured employers and insured employers with:
 1. An experience modification rating of less than 1.30 *and*
 2. An annual workers' compensation premium of at least \$5,000.Employers can earn a credit if they volunteer to start programs for:
 - Safety Programs
 - Drug and Alcohol Prevention, or
 - Return-to-Work

Bob Francis, Supervisor, On-Site Consultation, NYS Department of Labor will explain the details of the rule and the ways in which credit can be earned.
- **Conveyor Safety**, presented by **NYSCMA Member Daniel Polanco, Glenwood Superior Block**. Dan will share his unique experiences and tips for safe operation of conveyors inside and outside of the block plant.
- **Hearing Conservation**, presented by **Brian McKenna, Safety Director for Glenwood Superior Block**. Join us to learn more about the steps taken by Brian regarding hearing conservation in the plant since his appointment to the position of safety director at Glenwood.
- **NCMA's eSafetyLine Online Software**, demonstrated by **Joe O'Connor, Intec**. Intec provides products and services that assist employers in occupational safety and compliance. They have partnered with NCMA to develop the **eSafetyLine Online Software** specifically for block and paver producers. This presentation will review key elements for managing an effective and complaint safety program. Using NCMA's eSafetyLine online software, Joe will demonstrate how easily NYSCMA members can generate required documentation and conduct training. The software will also identify which records, such as training, injury and illness logs and inspection records, OSHA will request during an inspection of the plant. We encourage all members to join us for this program to learn the ways in which the NCMA eSafetyLine program can make safety compliance easier.
